If you ordered a package ahead of picture day earlier in October, your child will be bringing home their picture package in their backpack. If you haven't ordered yet, you can still order and preview the photos taken on picture day: visit <u>mylifetouch.com</u> and use Picture Day ID EVT23HSHB. If you need a Student ID, it is the same as your student's lunch code or login number.

Retake Day is Thursday, November 16th. If you are unhappy with your photos, return your original package on retake day and take new ones. If you haven't ordered yet or missed picture day, you can also have your picture taken on Retake Day. If you would like sibling photos, we will also be doing those on Retake Day. To pre-order sibling photos, use the same Picture Day ID as above, enter "**Siblings**" as the first name (make sure to include the "s" at the end) and the students' last name in the last name field and choose one of your children's grades.
