## 21st Century Recipe of the month

### Homemade Chicken Pot Pie

#### Ingredients:

- 1 2/3 cups frozen mixed vegetables
- 1 cup cut-up cooked chicken
- 1 can (10.5 oz) condensed cream of chicken soup
- 1 cup Original Bisquick mix
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 egg

#### Directions

- 1 Heat oven to 400°F. Mix vegetables, chicken and soup in ungreased 9-inch glass pie plate.
- 2 Stir together remaining ingredients with fork until blended. Pour into pie plate.
- 3 Bake 30 minutes or until golden brown.
