## **Media Access to Students**

## **Permission Form**

The Orange Public Schools have a media access policy and regulation. It requires written consent or parents or guardians before students are photographed, filmed, or interviewed on school grounds.

If your child is involved in an activity of special interest, we will need to have your permission to allow the media to take pictures of or interview your child. You must also inform us if you do not want to grant media permission under any of the following circumstances. Please check the appropriate boxes and sign and complete the form and return it to your child's school office.

The District sometimes takes photos of students in large groups, such as for concerts, the spring Olympics, and Recess Relay for Life. None of the children in these group photos are identified by name. However, parents may request that the district remove a group photo in which their child is depicted by calling either the school or Central Office, in which case the photo will be taken down.

District Webpage Permission: This requests permission for Orange Schools to use your child's photo on our district website or our SlideShare publications. Names will never be used with photos.		

Publication of Student Work: This requests permission for Orange to display your child's art work or written work on our district website or in district publications. We will use only your child's first name and grade level.			
Media Access: This refers to permission for other media to speak to or video your child in interviews (as in, Orange Town News) or television news. This would occur only with the permission and oversight of the school principal.
