Citizens' Ad Hoc Advisory Committees

The Orange Board of Education endorses appropriate ad hoc advisory committees for various district programs and activities. When it establishes an ad hoc committee, the Board shall provide guidelines for membership and delineate its responsibilities, authority, and meeting requirements pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act. At the October Board meeting each year, the Board shall review any existing ad hoc advisory committees, membership, and committee goals for the year.

All committees created by the Board of Education shall follow the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act as required by statute.
