The Orange Board of Education is committed to excellence in teaching, student achievement, community involvement, and general operations throughout the school district. Therefore, all supervisory personnel including principals, curriculum specialists, the 21st Century Director, the Director of Curriculum and Instruction, and the Superintendent shall be expected to create and maintain a work environment that encourages employee participation, enhances communications within the district, promotes the general welfare of students and the morale of staff. All employees are called upon to work cooperatively and openly in pursuit of our common goal of excellence.
