Preparation of Budget Document

The Board of Education (Board) asks the Superintendent to direct the preparation of the budget and submit it to the Board for its tentative approval and for a later public hearing.

The Superintendent confers with the school staff on budgetary needs, as well as considers priorities that have been determined by the Board. The Orange Board of Education shall review the Superintendent's proposed budget at one or more budget workshops and make additions and modifications to the tentative budget to bring it in line with the general philosophy of the Board and within the limits of what the Board projects as necessary based on available funds.

It is the policy of the Board that a liaison of the BOF be invited to attend the meetings of the Orange Board when the budget proposal is under discussion.

All Orange Board of Education budget meetings are public meetings, and the public is encouraged to attend and contribute to the budget development process within the specific guidelines for public participation at Board of Education meetings.
