Business and Non-Instructional Operations

Food Service – Purposes and Facilities

The school lunch program shall be an integral part of the district's total educational program. Administration of the food services program will be coordinated by the Business Manager and Cafeteria Manager under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools. Business functions to be centralized will include central purchasing of food and supplies, planned nutritionally balanced menus, and regular audit of all accounts.

The educational aspects of the school lunch program will be the responsibility of each building Principal, subject to advice, counsel and direction from the Superintendent of Schools and the Business Manager/Cafeteria Manager.
