## Instruction

## General

The Orange Board of Education believes the instructional program of the Orange Elementary Schools to be among its highest priorities, and it is therefore important for the Board and the professional staff to work cooperatively in determining annual educational goals and objectives to support the district's strategic plan which meets the needs of students.

Within limitations of budgets made available to it by the town, the Board of Education will provide personnel, equipment, instructional supplies and materials, and other support required to meet professional staff needs and community goals. The Board, understanding that education requires continuing change, also supports continuing in-service education for certified and non-certified staff.

The Superintendent of Schools shall present regular evidence of student progress and of program modifications based on evaluations, which are consistent with the district's strategic plan, goals, and objectives. Evidence of educational productivity is important in order to evaluate the educational system, to guide improvement efforts, and to develop public support for the schools.
