Parent Instruction of Children at Home

Parents wishing to educate their children at home may do so in compliance with Connecticut General Statutes and regulations of the Connecticut State Board of Education. When parents or guardians are willing to discuss their decision for equivalent education at home with school personnel, school district staff shall explain the advantages of a public school education to such parents or guardians without any criticism of parental choices.

When parents/guardians choose to educate their children at home, the school district shall provide whatever reasonable assistance it can to ensure that such children benefit appropriately from home instruction.

If decisions are made by parents or guardians to return their children to local schools who, for a time, have been educated at home, school staff shall provide a smooth transition to the public schools.
