Title I Parent and Family Engagement

The Orange Board of Education recognizes that parental and family involvement and engagement is vital to achieve maximum educational growth for students. Therefore, in compliance with federal law, the District will provide information regarding a school's participation in a Title I schoolwide program.

The Superintendent or his/her designee is directed to ensure necessary support among schools with teachers, administrators and other staff, and in the provision of curriculum materials and instructional supplies.

The Board directs the Superintendent to ensure that each of the District's schools participating in the Title I schoolwide program share information annually with the parents/guardians of students receiving Title I schoolwide services.

In cooperation with the District's policy, the Title I schoolwide plan will be reviewed annually and updated periodically as determined necessary, to meet the changing needs of participating schools and students.
