Instruction

Summer School

General

Within budget constraints, the district shall provide summer school programs of remediation and enrichment courses at all levels. Enrichment courses shall carry no credit.

Admission

Student attendance at summer school shall be voluntary, and transportation is the responsibility of parents/guardian, except for students enrolled in special education programs.

- 1. **Elementary.** Admission to elementary summer school classes will be limited to students who will be enrolled in grades 1-6 in September following the summer school session and who are current district residents.
- 2. Tuition. Tuition for the summer school program shall be determined annually by the Board of Education. Nonresidents may be admitted on a space available basis, and an additional fee will be assessed as established by the Board of Education.
