Planning

A facilities master plan for the Orange school district shall be developed and maintained with necessary changes to keep it up-to-date. The plan shall reflect the needs of current instructional procedures and projected educational programming and shall incorporate population projections, enrollment projections, site acquisition needs, school plant placement, and financial estimates of providing necessary school facilities.

The master facilities plan shall include how the district will provide an appropriate learning environment for its students which includes, (1) adequate instructional books, supplies, materials, equipment, staffing, facilities and technology, (2) equitable allocation of resources among its schools and (3) a safe school setting, and (4) ability to adapt to the changing needs of education. Attention shall also be given to how facilities can be utilized to improve academic achievement.
