Bylaws of the Board

Resignation/Removal from Office/Censure

Resignation

If for reasons of health, change in domicile, or any other compelling reason a member does decide to terminate service, the Orange Board requests as early as possible notification of intent to resign so that the Board may plan appropriately.

When a member of the Orange Board of Education shall cease to be a bonafide resident of Orange, his/her membership on the Board shall immediately cease.

Removal from Office

Any Orange Board officer may be removed from office by a two-thirds vote of the membership of the whole Board.
