The speakers expressed their gratitude and appreciation for the time that Dr. Scarpetti and Rosie Slowik have been spending in reviewing and addressing their interests and concerns.

Public comments concluded at 6:29 pm

The subcommittee addressed and refined 5113.2 (Truancy). In reviewing this policy, questions were identified:

- do we need a specific definition for 'full day' and 'half day'?
- what are the hours of the actual day?

The subcommittee addressed 5141.21 (Administer Medication) and reviewed written input and information from Doctor Robear. Further discussion followed, policy was tabled for another meeting.

The subcommittee addressed 5141.25 (Food Allergies) and 5141.26 (Food Allergy Plan & Guidelines). Further discussion with legal and medical guidance was identified as appropriate.

The subcommittee addressed 3240 (Tuition Fees) and agreed to present before the board a proposal that non-resident teachers pay 40% of the cost of tuition and 40% of the cost of 21<sup>st</sup> Century for their children should they choose to attend Orange Schools.

Executive Session was entered at 8:48 pm to address non-union hourly rates/salaries, and executive session concluded at 10:31 pm.

A motion to adjourn was made, seconded, and passed at 10:32 pm
