Excerpts in the minutes from the 9/12/16 policy subcommittee meeting were referenced by Mara

Mara invited Amy Wargo, Kai Byrd and Rosie Slowik to participate in the subcommittee's discussion on allergy policy

Regulation 5141.26R "Management Plan and Guidelines for Students with Food Allergies and/or Glycose Storage Disease" was addressed.

Aspects of allergy policy and sensitivity addressed included volunteers in school, addressing the topic in the beginning of the school year at "Open House," making school meal ingredients available online, areas in buildings where food is allowed and not allowed, general building use during, before, and after school including special events.

Having a "nut-free area" is something not currently in policy.

There were reports that the "48-hour notice" for celebration foods was not being adhered to, and discussion as to how to address ensued.

Unfinished and tabled topics were:

- What foods are allowed to go into any classroom
- What foods are allowed to go into the cafeteria
