1. The meeting was called to order at 7:03pm.
2. Public Participation

3. Science Kits – Grades K-3
The Next Generation Science Standards have been approved by the state, and in the next year, the students will be assessed on these standards. Dr. Russo would like to pilot a curriculum put out by the Smithsonian and Carolina. The committee reviewed curriculum materials and units. Dr. Scarpetti will ensure that the costs are in line with the budget line items. The committee approved the purchase.
4. Writing Process – On-Site Learning Plan
The writing process workshops will resume immediately when teachers return.
5. Buy-Back Old Devices - any devices that are looked upon to be discarded, will be evaluated for sale to a third party buyer.
6. Follow-Up Special Ed. Audit
A special education audit was completed three years ago and staff and administration have been following the recommendations of the audit. Dr. Scarpetti and Dr. Russo would like to hire a consultant to review the work that the district has done regarding goals and objectives. The special education budget will cover the cost of this consultant.
7. Technology Integration Database Specialist.
Matt Ullring would like to change the title of the position to Senior Technology Specialist. He would also like to change the title of Tier One Techs to Technology Technicians. Since the current Technology Integration Database Specialist is leaving, Matt Ullring is revising a job description in preparation for hiring a replacement.
