2. Discussion – Policy 5118.1 Homeless Students
Is Optional language necessary as delineated by CABA?
Should policy definition of homeless be included?
Include pre-school provided they have identified special needs.
Change “homeless students/children” to “children/students who are homeless.”
Change free school privileges to school privileges
Add the removal of existing barrier section from CABA to the Orange policy
Liaison is the Director of Special Services
Action for Rosie -- add a proof of residency form and a form detailing information as to what is available for families
3. Discussion – Policy 6172 – Alternative Education Program
This does not apply to Orange
4. Discussion – Food celebration approved snacks; striving for nut free, dairy free and gluten free
Cafeteria provided a list of possible snacks; Thurston provided labels for the snacks
ALL children should be able to eat them
Labels must be reread to prevent any issues – who would be doing that?
Storage is an issue
Seasonal availability of food is an issue/what is available when?
Room parents should/may include allergy parents
Any snack outside of vendor may incur some cost consideration pursuant to state regulation
Action for Mary Jo: cost per serving needed; explore other vendors; merge lists if possible
5. Discussion – Policy 3171.1 Non-Lapsing Account Education Fund
Board of Finance would have to approve the actual fund. We have a good relationship with the BOF
Do we need to have this policy – wait and see
6. Discussion – Policy 5136.6 – Alcohol Use, Drugs and Tobacco
Use the CABA policy and eliminate secondary (middle school and high school) references; eliminate alternative language.
7. Discussion – Policy 6164.11 – Drugs, Alcohol and Tobacco

8. Discussion – Policy 3240 – Tuition Fees
