

**Orange Board of Education
Curriculum/Instruction/Technology Sub-Committee Minutes
September 24, 2018**

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm.

2. Public Participation

There was no public participation.

3. Curriculum/Instruction/Technology Update

Dr. Russo shared drafts of the district's new Standards-Aligned Report Cards. The reporting for math and ELA will be based on a proficiency scale (P-Scale): 3 represents Adequate Understanding of Grade Level Common Core Standards, 2 represents Partial Understanding, and 1 represents Minimal Understanding. The reporting will also allow for teachers to add a .5 to each scale level (3.5, 2.5, and 1.5). Note: A 4 represents that a student is exceeding grade level expectations of Grade Level Common Core Standards.

Not all standards will be reported on the report card even though teachers will be teaching and assessing all standards. Standards have been prioritized for reporting purposes. Other subjects will use the former scale until the district is ready to fully switch to the new system.

The committee discussed how teachers will communicate to parents about the changes to the report card and what the report card communicates about their students' performance.

4. Update- Professional Development

Teachers have engaged in professional development to develop and review student tasks related to the standards and are prepared to administer those tasks to students.
