Vaccination is the best protection against the COVID-19 virus, and that is why **everyone 6 months to adults including seniors** are strongly encouraged to receive this truly lifesaving vaccine. This clinic is open to all staff, families, and students in our surrounding towns.

The Orange Health Department in partnership with Griffin Hospital and the DPH mobile van have scheduled a covid vaccine clinic for the children 6 months to seniors who are interested in getting vaccinated. This is a new bivalent vaccine which will include the Omicron BA.4/5 component to the current vaccine composition to create a new bivalent vaccine. The bivalent Covid 19 vaccine will be administered as a single booster dose to those who previously completed a primary series of Covid 19 vaccine. Both Pfizer and Moderna primary series will be available for those who have not finished their initial series. **Boosters are now available for the children 5 – 11 years.**

Please bring a health insurance card and photo ID if you have them, but it is not necessary to have health insurance or ID to receive the vaccine. No one will be turned away for lack of insurance or ID.
