5. Committee Reports / Updates

- Golf Tournament- Everyone came out and supported Peck both at the Tournament and then the after party. It was Very successful, wonderful time and we are looking for a chair for next year's event. We raised approximately \$11,030 at this time, but having checks still being cleared.

- Book Fair- Next week kicks off an in person Book Fair for kids. Flyers will be going home this week, you can send in cash/ check or create an ewallet for your child. In the past, you got back the money that wasn't used, however this year the excess money will remain in your child's wallet. The money goes back to the teachers and Peck. Every student will have the opportunity to go to the Book Fair as each class is allocated a time to go.
- Fall Fest- This year it will be at Townline Farm in Woodbridge. There will be hayrides, pumpkins, corn maize, arts and crafts and then you can purchase snacks or Pizza from a pizza truck.
